The law course provides a solid grounding in the concepts and principles which govern English law, from the origin of laws generally and specifically for some offences, the operation of this through the police and court system. In addition, students develop their legal reasoning and explanations through responding to scenarios and having to apply legal reasoning to cases and support their arguments with evidence.
